
The Government uses National Stock Number's (NSN) which contain sub-groups that identify the Federal Supply Groups (FSG), Federal Supply Classes (FSC), NATO Country Code, National Item Identification Number NIIN) and the serial number of the product.

A National Stock Number is simply the official label applied to an item of supply that is repeatedly procured, stocked, stored, issued, and used throughout the federal supply system. It is a unique item identifying series of numbers. When a NSN is assigned to an item of supply, data is assembled to describe the item.

HUBZone

Historically Underutilized Business Zone Program FAR subpart 19.13

The purpose of the HUBZone program is to provide federal contracting assistance for qualified s located in historically underutilized business zones in an effort to increase employment opportunities, investment, and economic development in such areas.

- SBA Certified: Status as a HUBZone small business is determined by SBA and a firm must apply for certification
- Every year the HUBZone must represent to the SBA that it continues meet all HUBZone eligibility criteria.

Requirements

- Principal Office: must be located in a HUBZone, except for concerns owned in whole or in part by one or more Indian Tribal Governments
- <u>Employee Requirement:</u> At least 35% of a concern's employees must reside in a HUBZone.

Business Development program administered by the Small Business Administration to support individuals that are socially disadvantaged and economically disadvantaged.

SBA grants supplier's entry into the 8(a) program and assigns them Business Opportunity Specialists at SBA District Offices

<u>Limited time program</u> for the suppliers to learn the contacting process; <u>graduate</u> <u>after nine years</u>

Source App Requests

- The Source Approval Request (SAR) must contain information about a prospective new supplier. IAW the Aviation Source Approval and Management Handbook 16 March 2011 Joint Aeronautical Commander's Group (JACG):
 - http://www.dla.mil/HQ/SmallBusiness/Business.aspx
- The SAR package must include all the technical data needed to demonstrate that the prospective supplier can competently manufacture or perform Repair, Overhaul, Maintenance and Modification (ROMM) of the item requiring source approval to the same level of quality or better than the system prime contractor, major subsystem contractor, or OEM.


Vendor Directed Solicitations Option in Registration

Solicitation Searches

Federal Supply Class (FSC): The first four digits of an NSN identifying the group and class of an item (e.g., 5905).

National Stock Number (NSN): A 13-digit number consisting of the FSC for the item followed by a nine digit identification number. This number is used to label and categorize each item that is stocked.

Solicitation Number: a 13-position alpha/numeric document identification number used to communicate government requirements to prospective suppliers.

Purchase Request Number: a 10-position numeric document identification number, which describes the required supplies so that procurement can be initiated.





Solicitation Searches

Nomenclature: The basic noun designation by which an item is commonly known (e.g., filter element, fluid).

Approved Part Number (P/N): This search is for approved part numbers on NSN buys described by manufacturer's CAGE and part number.

Approved CAGE: This search is for approved CAGEs on NSN buys described by the manufacturer's CAGE and part number.








Automated Solicitation

- Solicited by the DLA System Logic
- "T" in the 9th position of the solicitation number e.g. SPE4A1-19-<u>T</u>-2160.
- A T-Quote may be a candidate for an automated award.



Types of DIBBS RFQs

Manual Solicitation

Solicited by the Acquisition Specialist.

Have a letter "Q" in the 9th position of the solicitation number e.g. SPE4A1-19-**Q-**2019.

Acquisition Specialist manually posts to DIBBS.





Quote Submission

Submitting Web Form Quotes

- Users must be registered and logged into DIBBS in order to submit quotes. User registration in SAM must be up to date.
- After completing the quote form and reviewing the synopsis for accuracy, click "Submit".
- Users will receive a message indicating that the submission was "successful" or "unsuccessful".
- Submitted quotes may be viewed until the contract is awarded/cancelled. Revisions to quotes submitted on behalf of a CAGE will overlay previously submitted quotes for the same requirement.

Post Award Requests (PARs)

Once you receive the award, you may need to use PARs:

A Post Award Request (PAR) is an electronic request for postaward action or information on an award that can be created and submitted by suppliers via DIBBS.

- •PARs allow suppliers to communicate their requests for postaward action or information directly to the Post Award Administrator.
- •PARs provide tracking visibility into post-award actions and status.
- •Previous methods of processing and tracking post-award actions (email, phone, fax, etc.) should be managed by PARs to provide transparent tracking.
