



What's New in Small Business Regulations

Woman Owned Small Business (WOSB) and Economically Disadvantaged (EDWOSB) Competitive Set Asides

	WOSB Set Aside	EDWOSB Set Aside
Rule of two for set-aside	 Reasonable expectation that 2 or more WOSBs will submit an offer 	 Reasonable expectation that 2 or more EDWOSBs will submit an offer
	* Note: All EDWOSBs are WOSBs	* Note: Not all WOSBs are EDWOSBs

▼ WOSB and EDWOSB Sole Source Set Asides

- 13 CFR 127.503 (c) Sole source awards to EDWOSBs.
- A contracting officer may issue a sole source award to an EDWOSB when the contacting officer determines that:
 - The EDWOSB is a responsible contractor with respect to performance and the contracting officer does not have a reasonable expectation that 2 or more EDWOSBs will submit offers;
 - 2) The anticipated award price of the contract (including options) will not exceed \$6,500,000 (manufacturing), or \$4,000,000, other; and
 - 3) Award can be made at a fair and reasonable price.



- Limitations on Subcontracting (Section 1651 National Defense Authorization Act of 2013)
 - In the case of a contract for services, may not expend on subcontractors more than 50 percent of the amount paid to the concern under the contract
 - In the case of a contract for supplies (other than from a regular dealer in such supplies), may not expend on subcontractors more than 50 percent of the amount, less the cost of materials, paid to the concern under the contract

(Change from "cost incurred")

 Similarly Situated Entities - Contract amounts expended by a covered small business concern on a subcontractor that is a similarly situated entity shall not be considered subcontracted
